Welcome

College "Logos Centre" in Mostar at the business address Bišće polje bb is a modern higher education and research institution, which, based on the approval of the Ministry of Education, Science, Culture and Sports of the HN Canton independently performs basic academic programs of undergraduate study of the first (I) cycle, according to the Bologna process in three-year and four-year duration. College "Logos Centre" in Mostar was established as a permanent source of scientific and educational activities as well as innovative technologies and services that are needed for the national economic sector for its development and growth.

College Logos confirmed the superior quality of the teaching process by receiving the decision on institutional accreditation from the Ministry of Education, Science, Culture and Sports of Herzegovina-Neretva Canton no: 05-03-40-2016-7 / 15 on July 7th 2015. The decision was made upon the recommendation of the Agency for Development of Higher Education and Quality Assurance of Bosnia and Herzegovina; recommendation number: 05-33-1-37-6 / 15 on June 29th 2015. Accreditation of College "Logos Centre" enables easy identification and recognition of diplomas of Logos throughout Europe as it guarantees the implementation of the Bologna and European standards in the process of higher education.

Duration of studies at College "Logos Centre" in Mostar:

- I. Undergraduate study is of three academic year duration (six semesters), upon graduation the student acquires the total of 180 ECTS credits.
- II. Undergraduate study is of four academic year duration (eight semesters), upon graduation the student acquires the total of 240 ECTS credits.

Type of studies:

Basic information

"Logos Centre" College Mostar is an innovative, entrepreneurial and dynamic higher education institution, which establishes new rules, a new paradigm, and a new concept of modern higher education in BiH for generations, whose life and business career is reflected by entrepreneurship. Thus organized modern and flexible study with teaching plans and programs that do not suffer classical quality, but provides every individual to have the opportunity to unleash his creative and innovative potential, in a way that he can recognize his business opportunity and take advantage of it.

Accreditation

Pursuant to Article 26 and 27 of the Law on Higher Education in the Herzegovina-Neretva Canton (HNC Official Gazette, no. 04/12) and Article 18 of the Rulebook of Accreditation of higher education institutions and study programs (Official Gazette of HNC, no. 04/14) accreditation is a procedure in which the following is determined: meeting the universally accepted standards and norms with regard to the organization of work, available space, material-technical and human resources, the quality of the educational process, curricula and qualifications, and occupations for higher education, which results in the issuance of the decision on the accreditation of higher education institutions by the Ministry of Education, Science, Culture and Sport of HN Canton. The Ministry shall issue a decision on accreditation based on recommendations issued by the Commission of international and local experts in the field of higher education, who were appointed on the proposal of the Agency for Development of Higher Education and Quality Assurance of BiH (HEA).

A higher education institution assesses itself the degree of compliance of each of the criteria and on that basis it makes self-evaluation report submitted to the Ministry together with other documents. The Ministry shall submit self-evaluation report to the Commission for Accreditation selected on the proposal of the HEA, and after reading the report of the Commission shall schedule a visit to the higher education institution.



Importance of accreditation

Accreditation is a process that has the standardization of the organization of work, quality of spatial, material and human resources, the quality of the educational process, curricula and qualifications, and occupations for higher education as its results. Academic degrees, professional and scientific degrees and diplomas issued by higher education institutions without accreditation will not be recognized (Law on Higher Education HNC).

The main purpose of accreditation is to ensure harmonized level of quality among higher education institutions and to harmonize standards in higher education in Bosnia and Herzegovina with those of the European Union and other countries in Europe which apply ECTS system. The harmonization achieved through accreditation provides recognition of credits acquired at higher education institutions in BiH everywhere in Europe, and facilitated recognition of competences and diplomas at European universities.



Accreditation process on college "Logos centar"

College "Logos Centre" in Mostar submitted the request for institutional accreditation number: 546-2 / 14 to the Ministry of Education, Science, Culture and Sport of Herzegovina- Neretva Canton on 26th of September 2014. Ministry forwarded the submitted application and all supporting documents to the Agency for Development of Higher Education and Quality Assurance of Bosnia and Herzegovina with a proposal for the appointment of members of the Commission experts.

The Agency has appointed a Committee of national and international experts for quality assessment and audit of the recommendation on accreditation on February 24th 2015. , and the decision on the appointment to the Ministry on March 3rd 2015.

After examining the self-evaluation report, the Commission scheduled accreditation visit to the institution on 11th and 12th May 2015. During the accreditation visit, members of the Commission have had discussions with the management of the institution, the members of the team for making self-evaluation reports, administrators, professors, lecturers and assistants, students, alumni, representatives of the labour market, all with the aim of checking and proving the fulfilment of the criteria for accreditation.

Based on the Report of the Commission of experts College "Logos Centre" in Mostar meet the prescribed requirements for accreditation, the Agency for Development of Higher Education and Quality Assurance of Bosnia and Herzegovina adopted the recommendation number: 05-33-1-37-6 / 15 on June 29th 2015, and on that basis College "Logos Centre" in Mostar received a decision on institutional accreditation from the Ministry of Education, Science, culture and Sports of Herzegovina-Neretva Canton no: 05-03-40-2016-7 / 15 of 07th July 2015.

Successfully carried out accreditation process confirmed the quality and reputation of College "Logos Centre" as the best higher educational institution in the region. In addition, with the accreditation we have become part of the European higher education area and we enabled our students and professors the mobility through the provision and identical criteria and the quality of work existing on European universities. 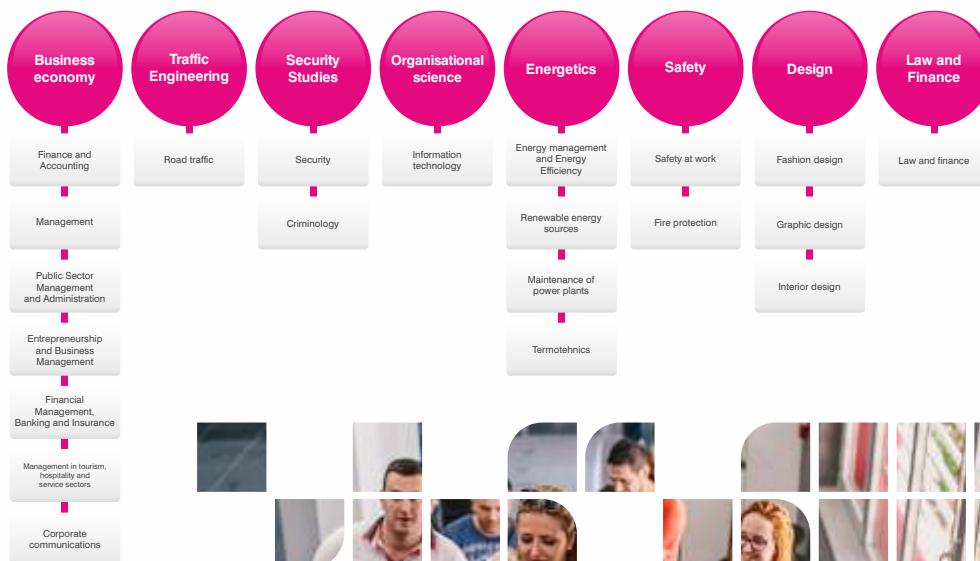


Diploma recognition in EU

Road Traffic

A systematic approach to transport policy of Bosnia and Herzegovina and the need for transport personnel are defined in the Transport Development Strategy of Bosnia and Herzegovina. Starting from the basic goals, forecasts and plans contained in the Transport Development Strategy is necessary to secure a sufficient number of trained and qualified personnel, which would ensure the realization of the goals.

The development of the transport system and the need for qualified staff have no alternative in Bosnia and Herzegovina. In this regard, in the last few years, number of laws and regulations were adopted, and number of bilateral and multilateral agreements were signed that deal with problems of traffic.

The study provides technical, technological and organizational training necessary for managing traffic processes, management of equipment and materials, and practical application of modern technologies and organization of traffic in order to achieve optimal technological and economic effects while protecting the environment.

Organisational science

The idea of introducing the study Organizational Sciences, the study direction of Information Technology, is to be seen only as an aspiration of the founder to make qualitatively a new step in the development towards a better and more fully meeting of the needs of the community for the corresponding burst of workers which is already more clearly recognized and imposed in the Herzegovina-Neretva Canton and in the counties in the region or other parts of the country.

- II. Undergraduate of Organizational Science, study course Information Technology is of four academic year duration (8 semesters), upon graduation, graduate acquires a total of 240 ECTS credits.

Security studies

Curriculum implies a strictly scientific criteria and requirements, given its relevance to agencies and other entities that have the function of protection and security of society and their organizational structure, which they should adapt and constantly question through concrete actions. In this way, through newest standards and scientific and experiential knowledge in the practice it will be able to effectively implement policies and strategies in the field of safety and to follow global trends in security studies.

By its nature Criminalistics is an interdisciplinary science. Its principles and rules are created and applied since ancient times. In the modern state that aims to be a state of the rule of law, place of Criminalistics as a science should not be questionable. It is an area that requires a systematic and thorough education tailored to the most developed democratic societies.



After completing undergraduate studies, which lasts for three academic years (6 semesters), upon graduation, graduate acquires a total of 180 ECTS credits Bachelor of Security.

Types of study and title acquired after graduation for the study direction Criminalistics:

- I. Undergraduate Study of Security studies, study course of Criminalistics is of three academic year duration (6 semesters), upon graduation, graduate acquires a total of 180 credits.
- II. Undergraduate Study of Security studies, study course of Criminalistics is of four academic year duration (8 semesters), upon graduation, graduate acquires a total of 240 credits.



Safety at work and fire protection

Safety at work is a set of technical, medical, legal, psychological, pedagogical and other activities, by which are detected and eliminated hazards that threatened the lives and health of people at work and determined the measures, procedures and rules in order to eliminate or reduce these risks.

The purpose of Safety is to create safe working conditions in order to prevent injury, occupational diseases and accidents at work or reducing any adverse consequences if the risk cannot be eliminated. Conducting safety is not limited only to occupational diseases, but seeks to prevent any illness or injury, but the greater attention is paid to occupational diseases.

The basic aim of the program Fire protection is to enable students to apply scientific and technical achievements in solving the problem of fire protection and for the development and management of fire protection systems.

Specific objectives of the program are to acquire knowledge and skills in the analysis and assessment of the risks of fire and explosion; development and application of methodology, methods, tools and procedures in the management of the system for fire and explosion protection; control system for fire protection; expertise fire and explosion; organization and management system for fire protection; design and quality management systems for fire protection; strategic planning and development of systems for fire protection; continuing education and development of skills in the field of fire protection; innovation activities and teamwork.

Safety at work and fire protection

Types of study and title acquired after graduation for the study direction Safety at Work:

After completing undergraduate studies, which lasts for three academic years (6 semesters), upon graduation, graduate acquires a total of 180 ECTS credits and the title: Bachelor Engineer of Safety at Work.

After completing undergraduate studies, which lasts four academic years (8 semesters), upon graduation, graduate acquires a total of 240 ECTS credits and the title: Bachelor Engineer of Safety at Work.

Types of study and title acquired after graduation for the study direction Fire protection:

I. Undergraduate Study of Fire Protection lasts three academic years (6 semesters), upon graduation, graduate acquires the title Bachelor Engineer of Fire Protection, with a total of 180 credits.

II. Undergraduate Study Fire Protection lasts four academic years (8 semesters), upon graduation, graduate acquires the title Bachelor Engineer of Fire protection, with a total of 240 credits.



Design

The methods and modes of learning at Design study will try to act in the area of developing critical and creative abilities of students. Design has a large impact on the wider community, because as an unavoidable discipline it is involved in the production, as of the objects and of the meaning. Therefore, education of designers must take into account various factors and incorporate them into a functioning methodical whole.

First of all, education of the Design students will have to shed light on the students in terms of the fundamental characteristics of form, viewing and communication and inform them in terms of rational critical research methods and analysis.

The study Design has the task of educating creative people, ready to promote and develop new opportunities in a variety of artistic disciplines, through individual and team work as well as their application in the modern market.

After completing undergraduate studies, which lasts four academic years (8 semesters), upon graduation, graduate acquires a total of 240 ECTS credits and title: Bachelor of Design- Fashion Design.

Energetics

Energetics is an economic activity that deals with the study and exploitation of different sources of energy and production of electric energy. It is essential for the development of the whole society. Modern economic development of any country depends entirely on the available energy resources, their utilization and application in production and consumption.

The program is opened and adjusted for mobility, free movement of students, access to study and learning, and the necessary services and the free exchange of teachers and researchers in accordance with the Bologna process. Programs are comparable with similar programs abroad, and are expressed in ECTS credits with the possibility of the implementation of the program in English.

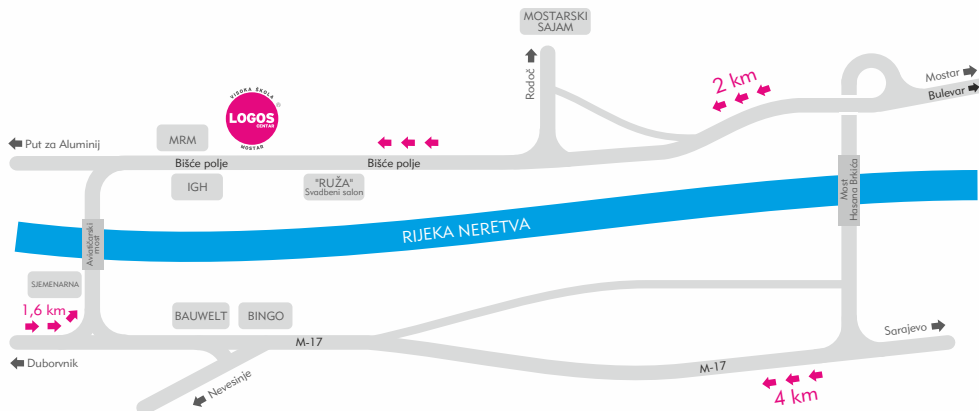
Documents required for admission

 - Certificate of Citizenship;
 - Two photos 4 x 6;
- Proof of payment for the enrolment materials;
- Proof of payment for the 1st study instalment;
- The entry sheet (obtained at the Student service);
- Semester sheet (obtained at the Student service).

Additional documents are required for students transferring from other higher education institutions:

- The index of the previous studies;
- Original transcript of grades from previous studies (or a certified copy of the index), and photocopies of diplomas for students who have graduated;
- The transcript of previous study curriculum if it is not made public or of the program in which the student attended classes and passed the exams isn't conducted no more.
