

Grading and credit System

Academic year starts on October 1 and end on September 30 of the following year. It is organised in two semesters. Winter semester starts in the first week of October and ends in the mid January and summer semester starts in last week of February and ends in the first week of June.

One study semester equals 30 ECTS for each study cycles.

Number of ECTS is determined based on the total time the student was engaged on a specific subject, such as

- Lectures (theory or/and practice, excercises, seminar papaers, etc.)
- Tasks (homework, projects, research work, etc.)
- Studying for the exam (test, final exam, etc.)

The sum of 60 ECTS is equal to average total engagement of student during the 40 working week hours in one academic year.

The student's score is expressed numerical, descriptive or alphabetical.

The grade consists of maximum 100 credits, and it is determined by the scale:

Grade letter	Grade	Grade range
A	5	Excellent, 90,0 – 100,0 credits
B	4	Very good, 75,0 – 89,0 credits
C	3	Good, 65,0 – 74,0 credit
D	2	Sufficient, 55,0 – 64,0 credits
F,FX	1	Insufficient, below 55 credits
